A positive experience can also be referred to as an experience where the teaching and learning can be supported. The Directorate has put into action one of the main priority areas, that of providing structured support through an established guidance team.

The team is made up of three guidance educators who can offer support on many dimensions throughout the learning experience. The guidance team can be present on the journey of learning from the very beginning together with potential learners who would like to take up a programme offered by the Directorate.

They would be able to assist the learners to make and take informed decisions throughout their learning pathway by preparing an individual plans and ensuring achievement of the set goals via follow-up sessions. This will allow the learner to delve deeper and analyse their needs with concurrent information about available courses, course pre-requisites, course levels, schemes related to learning programmes and possible job prospects together with the guidance educator.

The guidance team is also responsible for outreach activities and is currently building a network to be able to disseminate their services through many entities with the aim of reaching to as many persons as possible. The guidance educators can be reached through our Directorate and sessions can either be set up online or face-to-face depending on the learners' preference.

The Directorate holds in high regard and values the diverse needs of learners, the latter is in fact clearly visible in the guidance team's mission that of providing the necessary steppingstones towards an inclusive learning community.
